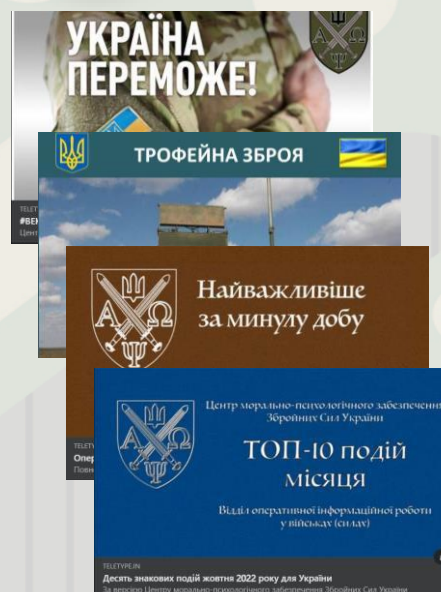

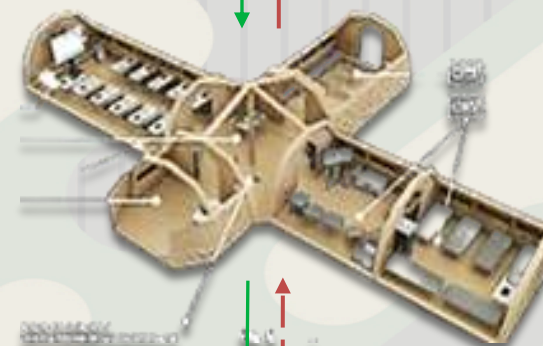

MENTAL HEALTH RECOVERY SYSTEM IN THE AREAS OF PERFORMING COMBAT TASKS



STAGE I

3-5 km →

PAP

Brigade (regiment)
Psychological
Assistance Point

Recovery duration
1-3 days

The brigade Psychological Assistance Point carries out rehabilitation activities for military personnel who have suffered mental combat injuries and are temporarily unable to perform assigned tasks.

STAGE II

150-200 km →



Specialized facility
in the task area

Recovery duration
5-7 days

In specialized recovery center located in the area of hostilities, rehabilitation activities are carried out for personnel who have suffered mental combat injuries and are temporarily unable to assigned center tasks

STAGE III

300-500 km →



Specialized
spa facility

Recovery duration
7-10 days

In specialized centers, rehabilitation activities are formulated personnel who have suffered mental combat injuries and are temporarily unable to perform assigned tasks.

STAGE IV

700-1000 km →



Specialized medical or
sanatorium institution

Recovery duration
14-21 days

In specialized institutions, **rehabilitation activities** are carried out for personnel who have suffered mental combat injuries and are unable to perform assigned tasks (combat tasks) **for a long duration of time**. At this facility family is can join the serviceman.



REINTEGRATION of POWs



1

STAGE

up to 48 hours

- triage and emergency care;
- recon, operational debriefing;
- return to duty or transfer to Stage 2 activities

2

STAGE

from 2 days to 1 month

- medical examination and care;
- post isolation decompression;
- tactical, formal, clarifying debriefing;
- psychosocial support;
- return to duty or transfer to Stage 3 activities

3

STAGE

from 1 to 12 months

- specialized medical care;
- medical-psychological, psychological rehabilitation;
- establishment of suitability for continuation of duties, clarifying debriefing;
- post isolation support;
- return to duty or dismissal from service

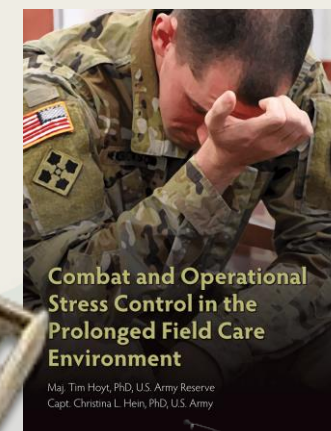

Training for military psychologists of the Armed Forces of Ukraine by NATO training groups (experience from OPERATION "INTERFLEX" UK)



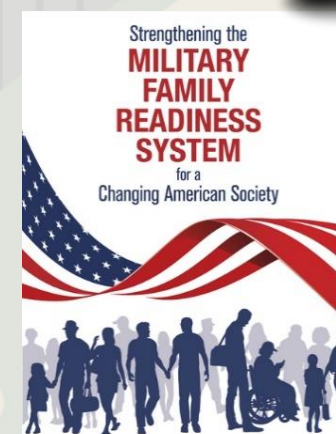
Psychological officers training utility, the SERE psychology curriculum from the USA
