THE OPPORTUNITY

Resources for BLV astronomy abound but are not broadly distributed. Space agencies and education organizations have created tactile materials, sonification tools, and accessible content—but resource creators and potential recipients remain separated by geography and discipline.

A4E is building a centralized, multidisciplinary hub that connects this small but passionate community.

- → Mentorship program pairing astronomers with local organizers

- → Model programs for amateur clubs to replicate
